Notice from the Department of Agriculture

The Department of Agriculture and Land Stewardship would like to clarify for our owners and breeders that we are now requesting a **copy** of the ***certificate of registration*** from the associations when you are sending in Broodmare Registration Applications and Transfer of Ownership forms. This will enable the Horse and Dog Breeding Bureau to verify the owner of the mare at the time of foaling.

The **Broodmare Registration Application**, Form M-4 must be submitted to the department 30 days prior to foaling.

This form must be accompanied by a copy of certificate of registration.

This registration will cover the mare her entire productive life as long as there is not a change of ownership and the mare meets the eligibility rules set forth in 62.15(2).

**A Transfer of Ownership**, Form M-6, must be submitted to the department when a mare already in the program is purchased by a new owner.

This form M-6 must be accompanied by a copy of certificate of registration.

(If your new certificate is not back from the association, please submit a copy of the original to the department with your paperwork. Once you receive the new certificate (issued in your name) please submit a copy of it to the department to complete your paperwork.

Mare Status Report Form M-5 must be enclosed with Mare Transfer of Ownership.
