NOMINATIONS AND NOMINATION PAYMENTS

REGISTRATION WITH THE IOWA DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE

On May 31, 2010 the horse must be registered as an Iowa-foaled horse with the Iowa Department of Agriculture and Land Stewardship under the provisions of 99D.22 of the Code of Iowa.

Nomination Payments: 2 & 3 year old pacers, 2 & 3 year old trotters

February 15.....\$125.00 for all fairs.

April 15.....\$125.00 for all fairs.

Starting Fees

Feature races\$50.00

NW \$2000 in 2010.....\$25.00.

If the February 15th payment is not made, a colt may become eligible April 15, 2010 by combining the February 15th and the April 15th payments **PLUS a \$125.00 penalty** or \$375.00.

PURSES - There is a \$20,000 purse for each of four classes listed above at each race meet. The \$20,000 purse includes the NW \$2000 in 2010 race with a guaranteed purse of \$1000 for each division at each fair.

CONDITIONS

1. All IaHHA Stakes payments are due postmarked February 15 and/or April 15.
2. Annual Membership Fee is \$15.00 + \$15.00 PAC Contribution. Each colt owner listed must be a member of IaHHA. If a colt is sold after nomination, the purchaser must be a member. There will be **NO** family memberships.
3. If an owner is found not to be a 2010 member of the IaHHA, a penalty of \$30.00 will be assessed, in addition to the regular \$15.00 membership fee. The penalty and fee must be paid before the colt may start.
4. Purse monies will be divided: Five - 45-25-15-10-5%. If less than 5 enter, purse money will be retained by the association.
5. All two and three year old horses must be registered with the Iowa Dept. of Agriculture as an Iowa foaled horse by May 31, 2010.

6. A two year old does not have to make nomination payments or start to be eligible to race as a three year old.
7. All owners must be 2010 USTA members and each colt must have met current USTA requirements.
8. Season trophies will go to the highest point colt and highest point filly in each division. Points given as follows: First - 10; Second - 6; Third - 4; Fourth - 3, Fifth - 2; No points awarded for the NW \$2000 in 2010 class or races at Prairie Meadows.
9. **If a race cannot be held due to rain out or other causes, the funding from Iowa Harness Horseman's Association for that particular meet or class or a particular division of a class will be carried forward to future scheduled races. The money will be divided by the number of remaining meets for that class. If the final race meet is rained out then the money for those rained out races will be divided among the horses entered to race on that date. Entry money paid to start and not contested will be refunded. The funds for Iowa Registered races will be divided among the horses entered to start. Races can be postponed at the discretion of the Superintendent of Speed for up to 24 hours after the last scheduled day of that race meet. Post time for postponed races will be determined at the time a rainout is called. If the races are postponed to a day that had other races scheduled, the races originally scheduled will start no earlier than advertised post time.**
10. DEFINITION FOR COLT AND FILLY RACES. All stallions and geldings will be called colts and all mares fillies.
11. In the event of an ENTRY of two horses of the same sex, only one can be drawn into a mixed division of the opposite sex.
12. Coupled entries will be allowed based on common ownership only. No coupled entries based on trainer or management will be allowed. It is the responsibility of the person entering the horse to indicate if the horse is an "ENTRY". Failure on the part of the trainer to indicate that a horse is an "ENTRY" will not be a cause for a redraw.
13. Fillies and colts will race in separate divisions. When there are four divisions or less, uneven fields between colts and fillies may be carded including less than five starters. There may be a mixed division if the separation of fillies and colts results in more than four divisions. In the event of a mixed division, fillies will draw for inside post positions.
14. **NON WINNERS OF \$2000 IN 2010 RACES.** Each class at each fair will have a division for the Non Winners of \$2000 in 2010. The purse for each of these races will be \$1000. Mixed divisions will be permitted and the rules for splits will follow the general overnight conditions in the circuit book. A minimum of 4 entries are required or the race will not be held. In the event the race is not held, horses entered will automatically be moved to the feature race, unless different instructions are given at the time of entry.
15. The fairs draw for all days at one time. Be sure to check date and time for each fair in Circuit book.
16. **As a condition of nominating to the Iowa Registered Colt races, participants agree to pre or post race blood or urine testings of horses competing in these races. Positive tests, as determined by the Iowa Harness Horseman's Association, will be subject to the penalty established by the Association. Specific 2010 medication rules will be published prior to the first race meet.**
17. **Any situation not covered by the above rules will be resolved by the IaHHA Board of Directors.**
