IOWA REGISTERED CHAMPIONSHIP RACES

October 1st & 2nd, 2022

All horses entered will be assigned to the championship, consolation, or C class races based on points and the tie breaker rules. Horses must have raced in at least one A class in 2022 to be eligible for the championship or consolation races. C class races will be split by overnight conditions. No claiming on C class races. All horses entered will be able to race.

Also, if there is only 1 horse for the consolation race, it will still be considered a race. There will be no minimum number of horses. Anything from 1 to 5 horses in the consolation races will be allowed.

The top 10 point winners that enter for the weekend of Oct 1st and 2nd, 2022 will be split into classes as follows:

2 YO filly trot 2 YO colt trot 2 YO filly pace 2 YO colt pace

3 YO filly trot 3 YO colt trot 3 YO filly pace 3 YO colt pace

Points are calculated using the Iowa Registered points system. A horse must be entered in a Featured Iowa Registered race (an "A" race) in 2022 in order to be eligible for the Championship or Consolation races.

A tie in points standing will be resolved by the following criteria:

- 1. Most starts in Iowa in 2022
- 2. Most earnings in Iowa in 2022
- 3. Flip a coin.

If (1) does not split the tie, then (2). If tie remains after (2), then (3).

Purses are as follows:

\$18,000 purse for class A Championship

\$6,000 purse for Consolation

\$3,000 purse for class C / overnight

Starting fee:

Championship races \$125

Consolation races \$75

Class C races \$25

Race dates:

Saturday, October 1st.... 8 Consolation Races
Sunday, October 2nd...... 8 Championship Races

Overnight races will be carded for Saturday, October 1st.

Aged Trot and Pace will be carded for Sunday, October 2nd.

All horses must be in the detention barn at least 4 hours prior to their scheduled post time. Stalls will be assigned ahead of time and all Lasix will be administered by the Vet. After competing EVERY horse must return to its assigned stall for blood collection. Every horse will have their blood sample sent in to be tested.

Lasix: All Lasix will be administered by a veterinarian hired by the IHHA for races on Sunday October 2nd, except Iowa Aged Horses. Lasix can be administered by trainers for races on October 1st.

Post-race testing on Saturday, October 1st will be done on a random basis on each race.

Trainers: No horse will be allowed to leave the barn except for warm-ups. Any horse that leaves the detention barn for any other reason will be scratched.

Points for horse of the year – Points will be awarded for championship and consolation races toward horse of the year honors as follows – 10-6-4-3-2.

Here are the times that horses need to be in the detention barn. They can be early but not late.
